### **Full Time Curator of Education Position Available**

The Museum of Early Trades & Crafts (METC), a New Jersey history museum located in Madison, New Jersey has an immediate opening for a full time Curator of Education. With the recent addition of our new Education Annex, the museum now has expanded capacity for all types of programming to engage the New Jersey community. The curator of education is responsible for developing and delivering all programming utilizing creative learning strategies that engage diverse audiences of students, families, people living with disabilities and older adults. They will be the lead educator for the museum and the liaison with the region's education community, ensuring curriculum relevance for all programs and exhibits. Additional responsibility includes securing partial funding for programming by identifying and developing grant opportunities and networking with colleagues, school administrators and teachers.

This is a leadership position which includes hands-on education, curriculum development, staff management, grant writing, departmental budgeting, and development of didactic materials. The ideal candidate will have exceptional writing and communication skills, extensive knowledge of museum pedagogy and interpretation and possess sound judgment. A collaborative management style and the ability to maintain effective working relationships with the museum's small staff and representatives of the community and other organizations is essential.

### **Minimum Education and Requirements:**

- Master's degree in museum studies, history, education, or a closely related field preferred.
- Minimum of 3-5 years' experience at a museum or historic site that includes program development and a proven track record of increased leadership responsibility.
- Experience with grant research and writing.
- A current driver's license.
